Tense

Present Simple

$$-S + V1 + ...$$

Past Simple

$$-S + V2 + ...$$





Present Simple

- I/you/we/they play football.
 - -Verb คือ play
- He/she plays football.
 - -Verb คือ plays
- When should you use an 's' with the verb?





Using regular verbs:

- First Person: I, we
 - -Rule: Do not use 's'
 - -Examples: I play football. We play football.
- Second Person: You
 - -Rule: Do not use 's'
 - -Example: You play football.





Using regular verbs:

- Third Person Singular: He, She
 - -Rule: Use 's'
 - -Examples: He plays football. She plays football.
- Third Person Plural: They
 - -Rule: Do not use 's'
 - -Example: They play football.

Using Irregular verbs: do, have

- First Person: I, we
 - -Rule: Do not use 's'
 - -Examples: I do it. We do it. I have it. We have it.
- Second Person: You
 - -Rule: Do not use 's'
 - Examples: You do football. You have it.

Using Irregular verbs: do, have

- Third Person Singular: I, we
 - -Rule: Use 's'
 - -Examples: I do it. We do it. I have it. We have it.
- Third Person Plural: They
 - -Rule: Do not use 's'
 - -Examples: They do it. They have it.
