Tense

- Present Simple
– S + V1 + ...
- Past Simple
– S + V2 + ...





Present Simple

- I/you/we/they **play** football.
– Verb คือ play
- He/she **plays** football.
– Verb คือ plays
- When should you use an 's' with the verb?





Using regular verbs:

- **First Person: I, we**
 - Rule: Do not use 's'
 - Examples: I play football. We play football.
- **Second Person: You**
 - Rule: Do not use 's'
 - Example: You play football.





Using regular verbs:

- **Third Person Singular: He, She**
 - Rule: Use 's'
 - Examples: He **plays** football. She **plays** football.
- **Third Person Plural: They**
 - Rule: Do not use 's'
 - Example: They **play** football.



Using Irregular verbs: do, have

- **First Person: I, we**
 - Rule: Do not use 's'
 - Examples: I do it. We do it. I have it. We have it.
- **Second Person: You**
 - Rule: Do not use 's'
 - Examples: You do football. You have it.



Using Irregular verbs: do, have

- **Third Person Singular: I, we**
 - Rule: Use 's'
 - Examples: I do it. We do it. I have it. We have it.
- **Third Person Plural: They**
 - Rule: Do not use 's'
 - Examples: They do it. They have it.
